## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

For the purpose of this analysis, the Department of Public Instruction will focus on the provisions of the bill that impact statutes relating to public instruction (specifically, ch. 119, Wis. Stats.).

Under current law, certain county officers may be removed from office by their appointing authority only for cause. This bill allows an appointing authority to remove these officers from office at pleasure.

Among the numerous changes in the bill, the bill amends s. 119.9001 (2) (c), Wis. Stats., which, as amended, provides that the commissioner of an opportunity schools and partnership program shall report to the county executive and may be removed from office only by the county executive at pleasure. The bill does not impact appropriations; therefore, there is zero fiscal impact to the state or Department as a result of the change in this bill.
