



2017 SENATE BILL 466

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 285.72 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** prohibiting the use of
2 the Sheboygan Kohler-Andrae air quality monitor in the state monitoring
3 network plan.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 4.** 285.72 (3) of the statutes is created to read:
5 285.72 (3) (a) The department may not include the air monitoring site located
6 at Kohler-Andrae State Park in Sheboygan County in the state's initial monitoring
7 network plan required under 40 CFR 58.10.
8 (b) The department shall request a waiver of the relevant provisions of the
9 federal Clean Air Act relating to the state implementation plan, as required under
10 42 USC 7410, that may be implicated by discontinuing the use of the air monitoring
11 site located at Kohler-Andrae State Park in Sheboygan County.

SENATE BILL 466**SECTION 4**

1 (c) If the federal environmental protection agency does not approve the initial
2 plan submitted by the department under par. (a), the department may submit a
3 revised plan that includes the air monitoring site located at Kohler-Andrae State
4 Park in Sheboygan County.

5 **SECTION 6. Initial applicability.**

6 (1) The treatment of section 285.72 (3) (a) of the statutes first applies to a
7 monitoring network plan submitted on January 1, 2018.
