Jeff and Cory,

As we discussed, if you would like to amend AB 314 to allow the use of a mechanized lift system attached to a stationary motor vehicle as a hunting platform, while leaving it up to the hunter or mentor to decide what types of mechanized lifts are appropriate and safe, you could amend the bill as follows:

In proposed s. 167.31 (4) (j), provide that "Subsection (2) (b) and (c) does not apply to a person legally hunting from a stationary vehicle if the person is hunting from a part of the vehicle or from a piece of equipment attached to the motor vehicle that is raised by mechanical means at least 5 feet above the ground or at least 5 feet above the lowered resting position of the part of the motor vehicle or piece of equipment attached to the motor vehicle, whichever is higher."

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: authorizing hunting from a mechanized lift attached to a motor vehicle.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 167.31 (4) (j) of the statutes is created to read:

×167.31 (4) (j) Subsection (2) (b) and (c) does not apply to a person legally hunting

from a stationary motor vehicle if the person is hunting from a part of the vehicle or

a piece of equipment attached to the vehicle that is raised by mechanical means not

less than 5 feet above the ground or the lowered resting position of the part or piece

of equipment, whichever is higher.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

- 1 (1) This act first applies to a person hunting on the effective date of this subsection.
