SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 473

December 4, 2017 - Offered by Senators TESTIN and JOHNSON.

Page 2, line 9: delete lines 9 to 13.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 3, line 6: delete "known" and substitute "known, based on the
3 information provided by the person making the report,".

4 2. Page 3, line 11: delete lines 11 to 13 and substitute "crime alert network to
5 disseminate the report as soon as practically possible if the law enforcement agency
6 determines that all of the following apply:".

7 3. Page 3, line 13: after that line insert:

8 "1. There is reason to believe that the veteran at risk is missing due to his or
9 her physical or mental health condition.

10 2. There is sufficient information available to disseminate that could assist in
11 locating the missing veteran.".
