*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 2g.** 20.435 (1) (b) of the statutes, as affected by 2017 Wisconsin Act  
4             59, is amended to read:

13 **SECTION 3. Nonstatutory provisions.**

14 (1) ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE GRANTS. In the 2017-19 fiscal biennium, the  
15 department of health services shall award grants in a total amount not to exceed  
16 \$500,000 for the purpose of increasing awareness of Alzheimer's disease and  
17 dementia in rural and underserved urban areas.

18 **SECTION 4. Fiscal changes.**

19 (1) ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE GRANTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the  
20 statutes for the appropriation to the department of health services under section  
21 20.435 (1) (b) of the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2017-18 is increased  
22 by \$500,000 to award grants under SECTION 3 (1) of this act.

23 **SECTION 5. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the day after publication,
