1 AN ACT *to amend* 20.435 (7) (bc) of the statutes; **relating to:** grants for
2 Alzheimer's disease and dementia awareness and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services to award grants to increase awareness of Alzheimer's disease and dementia in rural and underserved urban areas.

18 dementia in rural and underserved urban areas.

SECTION 4. Fiscal changes.

19 (1) ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE GRANTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the
20 statutes for the appropriation to the department of health services under section
21 20.435 (7) (bc) ^{(1) (b)} of the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2017-18 is increased
22 by \$500,000 to award grants under SECTION 3 (1) of this act.
