Other Provisions (Page 550)

1. DELETE TRANSFER OF PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

Senate Republicans: Delete the non statutory provision under 2015 Act 60 Section 115(1), which directs Milwaukee County to transfer, unencumbered, to the Wisconsin Center District, the property known as the Marcus Center for the Performing Arts (929 North Water Street, Milwaukee, WI). The provision specifies that the transfer must take effect upon the adoption of a resolution requesting the transfer by the Wisconsin Center District board of directors and a written proclamation of the Milwaukee County Executive supporting the transfer, notwithstanding any policies issued, ordinances enacted, or resolutions adopted by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors to the contrary and would not require approval of the county board.

SECTION 115. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) CERTAIN MILWAUKEE COUNTY PROPERTY. As soon as practicable, Milwaukee County shall transfer, unencumbered, to a district created under subchapter II of chapter 229 of the statutes, the property known as 929 North Water Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, which is bounded by the Milwaukee River on the west; East State Street on the north; North Water Street on the east; and East Kilbourn Avenue on the south. The transfer shall take effect upon the adoption of a resolution requesting the transfer by the board of directors under section 229.41 (2) of the statutes and a written proclamation of the Milwaukee County executive supporting the transfer, notwithstanding any policies issued, ordinances enacted, or resolutions adopted by the Milwaukee County board to the contrary. The transfer may take place without the approval of the Milwaukee County board.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill repeals a provision created in 2015 Wisconsin Act 60 ^{that} which requires Milwaukee County to transfer, unencumbered, the Marcus Center for the Performing Arts to the Wisconsin Center District (WCD). The provision specifies that the transfer must take effect upon the adoption of a resolution requesting the transfer by the WCD board of directors and a written proclamation of the Milwaukee County executive supporting the transfer, notwithstanding any action taken by the Milwaukee County board to the contrary. The transfer may take place without county board approval.

For further information see the *local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) 2015 Wisconsin Act 60, section 115 (1) is repealed.
