**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 483**

November 20, 2017 - Offered by Representative JAGLER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: before “eliminating” insert “religious exemption from
3 dwelling construction standards,”.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 6: delete “Council” and substitute “Council,”.

5 **3.** Page 5, line 20: after that line insert:

6 **“SECTION 18m.** 101.648 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 101.648 (1) (b) “Dwelling construction standard” means a requirement
8 imposed under s. 101.645 (3) or 101.647 (3) or a requirement imposed under any
9 provision of ch.101 or 145 applicable inside one- and 2-family dwellings or under any
10 ordinance of a political subdivision relating to standards for electrical wiring or
11 plumbing in applicable inside one- and 2-family dwellings.”.
