1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 5: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 1m. 77.707 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 77.707 (1) Retailers and the department of revenue may not collect a tax under
5 s. 77.705 for any local professional baseball park district created under subch. III of
6 ch. 229 after December 31, 2019, or the last day of the calendar quarter that is at least
7 120 days from the date on which the local professional baseball park district board
8 makes a certification to the department of revenue under s. 229.685 (2), whichever
9 is earlier, except that the department of revenue may collect from retailers taxes that
10 accrued before the day after the last day of that calendar quarter and fees, interest
11 and penalties that relate to those taxes."
