Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill changes certain procedures in appellate proceedings related to termination of parental rights (TPR) cases.

The bill adds two new requirements in appellate proceedings: (1) it requires the signature of the person on whose behalf the appeal is being filed to be included in the notice of intent to appeal; and (2) it requires an appellant who files a motion for remand that would allow for post-judgment fact-finding to file an affidavit in support of the motion that states with specificity why the post-judgment fact-finding is necessary.

This bill will have no direct fiscal impact on the state court system.
