AN ACT to create 323.12 (4) (e) of the statutes; relating to: waiver of certain fees

during a declared state of emergency.

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes the governor, during a state of emergency declared by the governor, to waive any fee required by the state for the replacement of a permit, license, approval, or other authorization for a person who resides or is headquartered in the area covered by the state of emergency.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 323.12 (4) (e) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 323.12 (4) (e) At his or her discretion, waive any fee required by the state for the replacement of a permit, license, approval, or other authorization for a person
- 6 who resides or is headquartered in the area to which the governor's executive order

- under s. 323.10 applies and whose permit, license, approval, or other authorization
- is lost or destroyed in connection with the state of emergency.
