1 AN ACT *to create* 323.12 (4) (e) of the statutes; **relating to:** waiver of certain fees  
2 during a declared state of emergency.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill authorizes the governor, during a state of emergency declared by the governor, to waive any fee required by the state for the replacement of a permit, license, approval, or other authorization for a person who resides or is headquartered in the area covered by the state of emergency.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3 SECTION 1. 323.12 (4) (e) of the statutes is created to read:  
4 323.12 (4) (e) At his or her discretion, waive any fee required by the state for  
5 the replacement of a permit, license, approval, or other authorization for a person  
6 who resides or is headquartered in the area to which the governor's executive order

**SECTION 1**

1 under s. 323.10 applies and whose permit, license, approval, or other authorization  
2 is lost or destroyed in connection with the state of emergency.
