**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 805**

1 **AN ACT to repeal** 118.55 (2) (b); **to renumber and amend** 118.55 (2) (a); and **to**
2 **create** 118.55 (10) of the statutes; **relating to:** excluding certain college credit
3 in high school programs from the Early College Credit Program.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 118.55 (2) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 2017 Wisconsin Act 59,
5 is renumbered 118.55 (2) and amended to read:

6 118.55 (2) ENROLLMENT IN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION; APPLICATION.
7 Subject to ~~par. (b)~~ and sub. (7t) (c), any public high school pupil who is not attending
8 a technical college under s. 38.12 (14) or 118.15 (1) (b) and any high school pupil
9 attending a private school may enroll in an institution of higher education for the

1 purpose of taking one or more nonsectarian courses at the institution of higher
2 education, including during a summer semester or session. The pupil shall submit
3 an application to the institution of higher education in the previous school semester.
4 The pupil shall indicate on the application whether he or she will be taking the course
5 or courses for high school credit or postsecondary credit or both, if applicable. The
6 pupil shall also specify on the application that, if he or she is admitted, the institution
7 of higher education may disclose the pupil's grades, the courses that he or she is
8 taking, and his or her attendance record to the public or private school in which the
9 pupil is enrolled.

10 **SECTION 2.** 118.55 (2) (b) of the statutes is repealed.

11 **SECTION 3.** 118.55 (10) of the statutes is created to read:

12 118.55 (10) INAPPLICABILITY. (a) In this subsection:

13 1. "Private, nonprofit institution" means a private, nonprofit postsecondary
14 institution that is a member of the Wisconsin Association of Independent Colleges
15 and Universities or any successor organization.

16 2. "University of Wisconsin System institution" means a 4-year institution in
17 the University of Wisconsin System.

18 (b) This section does not apply to a course for which a public high school pupil
19 may earn postsecondary credit if all of the following apply:

20 1. The school board of the school district and one of the following have entered
21 into an agreement before, on, or after the effective date of this subdivision [LRB
22 inserts date], to provide a college credit in high school program to academically
23 qualified pupils under which participating pupils may take the course for
24 postsecondary credit:

25 a. The chancellor of a University of Wisconsin System institution.

- 1 b. The president of a private, nonprofit institution.
- 2 2. The instruction of pupils in the course takes place in a school building in the
3 school district or a school district facility.
- 4 3. The individual who provides instruction in the course is any of the following:
- 5 a. For a course taught pursuant to an agreement under subd. 1. a., a high school
6 teacher who is employed by the school district and certified or approved to provide
7 the instruction by the participating University of Wisconsin System institution or a
8 faculty member of the participating University of Wisconsin System institution.
- 9 b. For a course taught pursuant to an agreement under subd. 1. b., a high school
10 teacher who is employed by the school district and certified or approved to provide
11 the instruction by the participating private, nonprofit institution or a faculty
12 member of the participating private, nonprofit institution.
- 13 (c) This section does not apply to a course for which a high school pupil
14 attending a private school may earn postsecondary credit if all of the following apply:
- 15 1. The governing body of the private school and one of the following have
16 entered into an agreement before, on, or after the effective date of this subdivision
17 [LRB inserts date], to provide a college credit in high school program to
18 academically qualified pupils under which participating pupils may take the course
19 for postsecondary credit:
- 20 a. The chancellor of a University of Wisconsin System institution.
- 21 b. The president of a private, nonprofit institution.
- 22 2. The instruction of pupils in the course takes place in the private school
23 building.
- 24 3. The individual who provides instruction in the course is any of the following:
