Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill excludes certain college-level courses offered to high school pupils enrolled in a public school from the Early College Credit Program if they meet specific criteria.

The Early College Credit Program (ECCP) is a new program that was assigned to the Department of Workforce Development(DWD) as part of the 2017-19 Biennial Budget and will not begin until July 1, 2018. Since DWD has not promulgated rules for this program yet, if the bill is adopted during the current session, it's provisions can be incorporated in to the new DWD rules.
