Rick,

Rep. Barca would like to request some amendments to SA 1 to AB 748. When possible we'd like to retain as much of AA4, but generally our intent is to expand what had been in the Assembly amendment to allow for provisions statewide rather than simply the EITM zone.

In the first, we would like to retain section 1 of from AA4 (and anywhere else necessary) to allow for job training and apprenticeship programs and requirements, but statewide rather than only in the EITM-zone.

In the second, we would like to amend to either modify or, if necessary, include additional language to carve out to allow for local hiring provisions to be used anywhere in the state. I believe these are largely potentially restricted in the created 66.0134 (2) and (3) and may need language added to exempt local hiring preferences from the restriction under the bill.

The third would, with the exception of sections 2 and 3 related to hours/overtime/scheduling, retain all the provisions of AA4, but make them statewide rather than EITM zone-specific. Sections 2 and 3 would be untouched and the bill's provision would survive.
