2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 356

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 256.15 (5) (a) and 256.15 (10); and *to create* 256.15 (8) (cm)
2 of the statutes; **relating to:** licensure or certificate renewal for certain
3 emergency medical services personnel and ambulance service providers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 256.15 (5) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 2017 Wisconsin Act 12,
5 is amended to read:
6 256.15 (5) (a) Except as provided in ss. 256.17 and 256.18, the department shall
7 license qualified applicants as ambulance service providers or emergency medical
8 services practitioners. The department shall, from the information on the
9 certification form specified under sub. (6) (c) 2., establish in each ambulance service
10 provider's biennial license the primary service or contract area of the ambulance
11 service provider.

ASSEMBLY BILL 356**SECTION 2**

1 **SECTION 2.** 256.15 (8) (cm) of the statutes is created to read:

2 256.15 **(8)** (cm) Every holder of a certificate issued under sub. (8) shall renew
3 the certificate every 3 years by applying to the department on forms provided by the
4 department. Upon receipt of an application for renewal containing documentation
5 acceptable to the department that the requirements for certification have been met,
6 the department shall renew the certificate unless the department finds that the
7 applicant has acted in a manner or under circumstances constituting grounds for
8 suspension or revocation of the certificate.

9 **SECTION 3.** 256.15 (10) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 256.15 **(10)** LICENSE RENEWAL. Every holder of a license issued under sub. (5)
11 or (7) shall renew the license ~~on July 1 of each even-numbered year~~ every 3 years by
12 applying to the department on forms provided by the department. Upon receipt of
13 an application for renewal containing documentation acceptable to the department
14 that the requirements of sub. (6) have been met, the department shall renew the
15 license unless the department finds that the applicant has acted in a manner or
16 under circumstances constituting grounds for suspension or revocation of the
17 license.
