Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, the Department of Public Instruction must establish a mental health training support program to provide training to school district staff and instructional staff of independent charter schools on screening, brief intervention, and referral to treatment program, also known as SBIRT, trauma sensitive schools, and youth mental health first aid.

This bill increases the funding for this mental health training support program by \$1,000,000 for the 2018-19 school year.

State: This bill would increase state expenditures by \$1 million GPR in FY19.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The \$1 million GPR appropriated, beginning in FY19, would be an ongoing state expenditure unless it was changed in the future by the Legislature.
