Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The State Public Defender (SPD) is statutorily authorized and required to appoint attorneys to represent indigent defendants in criminal and certain commitment proceedings. The SPD plays a critical role in ensuring that the Wisconsin justice system complies with the right to counsel provided by both the state and federal constitutions. Any legislation has the potential to increase SPD costs if it creates a new criminal offense, expands the definition of an existing criminal offense, or increases the penalties for an existing offense.

Current law requires an investigation following a death that involves a law enforcement officer. The protocol requires that a report be provided to the District Attorney (DA), and s/he determines whether or not to prosecute the officer.

This bill requires that a report be provided to the chief judge of the judicial administrative district, rather than the DA, and the judge must appoint a special prosecutor who will determine whether or not to prosecute the officer.

The SPD does not anticipate an increase in its caseload and/or costs as a result of this proposal.
