Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill would create a nonrefundable credit equal to \$2,500 for each employee who is employed through the Milwaukee Institute of Art and Design apprenticeship program funded by an American Apprenticeship Initiative grant through the U.S. Department of Labor. The business must be located in Wisconsin and engaged in a design apprenticeship activity consistent with the purposes for which the school received the grant. The maximum amount of the credit that may be claimed for all claimants and all taxable years is \$750,000. The credit would be available for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2017.

Fiscal Estimate

The bill would reduce income and franchise tax revenue by \$750,000, the overall limit for claims by all taxpayers for all years in the bill. The fiscal effect could be spread over multiple fiscal years, depending on when and the amount of credits that are certified.
