Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law prohibits the Wisconsin Technical College System Board or Districts from discriminating against a student on the basis of a race, color, creed, religion, sex, national origin, disability, ancestry, age, sexual orientation, pregnancy, marital status or parental status. AB 418 expands prohibited discrimination to include discrimination on the basis of a person's gender identity or gender expression.

The bill would have no fiscal effect on the Wisconsin Technical College System.
