Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department to annually issue 5 Upriver Sturgeon Spearing licenses to Sturgeon for Tomorrow, Inc., who may award the spearing licenses as prizes at a raffle. The raffle winners must pay the appropriate license fee for the awarded Upriver Sturgeon Spearing license prior to obtaining the license. In addition, a person may be issued only one Upriver Sturgeon Spearing license under this program in his or her lifetime.

Costs

IT system development (one-time cost):

New products (authorization to purchase and spearing license) would need to be created and tested in the recreational license delivery system (Go Wild) to apply the requirement that a person may only receive one spearing license awarded through this raffle once in a lifetime.

It is estimated 5 hours of business analyst time would be required to create and test these products, for an anticipated total one-time IT labor cost of \$2,500 [5 hours IT development * \$50/hour (average business analyst rate plus fringe)].

Raffle winner Go Wild account administration (annual cost):

This bill will increase annual labor costs related to department Customer Service Representative (CSR) staff time required to administratively post an authorization to purchase an Upriver Sturgeon Spearing license to the five raffle winners' Go Wild customer accounts. If the raffle winners do not possess a Go Wild account, the CSR will need to contact the raffle winners to obtain their personal information in order to create a Go Wild account. Following posting of the authorization to purchase an Upriver Sturgeon Spearing license, the CSR will then need to contact each raffle winner to inform them they are authorized to purchase their license at any DNR license agent.

Assuming each raffle winner will need a Go Wild customer account established and 1 hour CSR staff time is required per raffle winner, it is anticipated the estimated the cost to administratively manage the raffle winners' Go Wild accounts would be \$120 per year [1 hour/raffle winner * 5 raffle winners/year* \$24/hour (average CSR rate plus applicable fringe)].

The total cost to implement the provisions of this bill is anticipated to be \$2,620 the first year (\$2,500 + \$120) and \$120 per year thereafter.

Revenue

Since this bill requires raffle winners to purchase the sturgeon spearing license awarded through the raffle, revenue collected is not anticipated to be impacted by the bill.
