Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes certain changes to statutes regulating the production, use, sale, distribution and possession of marijuana. Prosecutor responses varied from saving time and money due to fewer prosecutions of minor drug offenses, to increasing caseloads due to related prosecutions such as traffic violations, driving while impaired, marijuana possession by minors and traffic deaths. Consequently, the fiscal impact of the legislation is indeterminate.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The long-range fiscal implications of this legislation on DA's offices are indeterminate.
