Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB-646 creates new statutory reporting requirements for recipients of WEDC grants, loans or tax credits.

Under direction from the WEDC Board of Directors, the corporation implemented award administration policies and procedures requiring recipients of job creation/retention awards to notify the corporation within thirty days (30) if any net full-time positions in Wisconsin are reduced or relocated out of Wisconsin. In addition, WEDC requires all applicants to certify that assistance is needed to ensure projects will take place in the state.

Under the current proposal, WEDC would be able to absorb the additional costs of the new statutory requirements described in this bill.
