Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a new appropriation that would be administered by the Department of Children and Families for the purpose of providing grants to at least four University of Wisconsin System institutions or technical colleges within the Wisconsin Technical College System. A total of \$120,000 GPR is provided in SFY 19 in the new biennial appropriation. No individual grant may exceed \$30,000. The purpose of the grant funding is to provide resources, programs, and activities for former foster youth enrolled in the university or technical college. Foster youth are defined as those youth who resided in an out-of-home placement (foster care) from the time of his or her 13th birthday for at least one year or youth who left foster care upon turning 18 years of age.

The fiscal effect of the bill is \$120,000 GPR increase over the current budget.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The fiscal effect of the bill moving into the next biennium is an increase of \$240,000 GPR over the base budget.
