Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill modifies the types of placement and transfer facilities available to a juvenile who has been adjudicated delinquent under the Juvenile Justice Code for an act punishable by a sentence of six months or more if committed by an adult and who is found to be a danger to the public and in need of restrictive custodial or correctional placement. Additionally, this bill grants DCF authority to license a county department, in addition to a child welfare agency, to operate a secured residential care center for children and youth (SRCCCY) and grants those county departments the same authority as DOC to supervise juveniles placed in an SRCCCY.
