Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB 964 provides that it is not unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, unfairly discriminatory, or preferential or otherwise unreasonable or unlawful if the water public utility increases its rates and uses the revenues from the rate increase to pay for replacing lead service lines, providing water filters, or other public health measures related to mitigating lead in residential customers' water resulting from lead service lines. To use ratepayer revenues for these purposes, the water public utility would apply to the Public Service Commission (Commission) for adjustment to its water rates, and the Commission would include in water rates the service line replacement, filter, or other costs specified in the bill.

AB 964 would likely result in an increase in the number and complexity of rate increase applications submitted to the Commission and would require additional Commission staff resources to update utility tariffs to allow use of ratepayer dollars for purposes outlined in the bill. In addition, the bill would likely increase the number of utility and customer inquiries and complaints submitted to the Commission about lead service line replacement and rate impacts. This bill will increase costs to the Commission by an estimated \$88,500 of salary, fringe and supplies related to expenditures associated with 1 FTE.
