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## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill allows the Office of Education Opportunity (OEO) in the University of Wisconsin System to contract with an organization to operate a four-year, recovery charter school for no more than 15 high school students. The school must provide substance abuse counseling for the students and provide a curriculum which allows the students to graduate from high school. To enroll, the students must be in recovery for a substance use disorder, have been sober for at least 30 days, are willing to submit to drug screening and possible drug tests. The bill proposes the substance abuse counseling and care costs will be billed to the child's medical insurance coverage.

The bill directs the Department of Health Services to perform two duties. The first is to seek and apply for any federal moneys in the 2017-19 biennium which could be used by the OEO to fund the school. Secondly, after its fourth year of operations the director of the charter school must provide a report to the Department. The report must be about the operation and effectiveness of the charter school, and must include an evaluation of the effectiveness of the charter school on long-term student recovery outcomes.

The Department should be able to absorb these additional duties within its operating structure.
