Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a grant program, administered by the Department of Justice, to award grants to school districts, operators of independent charter schools, governing bodies of private schools, and tribal schools to improve school safety.

Under the bill, DOJ must, in consultation with the Department of Public Instruction develop a plan for awarding the grants. The plan must include what expenditures are eligible to be funded by a grant, including expenditures related to the employment of armed school safety officers and safety-related upgrades to school buildings, equipment, and facilities.

This bill creates a new \$100 million continuing appropriation in fiscal year 2017-18 for the purpose of providing grants for school safety.

Local Indeterminate- Since school safety needs, costs, and priorities will vary across the state, and it is unknown the number of public school districts, private schools, independent charter schools, and tribal schools that will apply for these grants, the costs are indeterminate.

State- This bill will increase state expenditures up to \$100 million if all grant funds are allocated.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Should the entire \$100 million appropriation be expended, no further grants could be awarded unless additional funding is provided by the Legislature for this program.
