Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB-128 would likely shorten the amount of time law enforcement requires to obtain a search warrant for a civil violation of operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated (OWI) and prohibited alcohol concentration (PAC) violations, and it would expand the pool of persons available that can fulfill warrant requests. This would decrease costs to law enforcement agencies. As the time spent on these activities is highly variable, the decrease in costs is indeterminate.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
