### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill increases the penalty for the crime of patronizing a prostitute from a Class A misdemeanor to a Class I felony if the person has been previously convicted of that crime at least two times. Under the bill, a first or second violation remains a Class A misdemeanor.

DOC estimates that there will be no financial impact as a result of this bill. DOC has no inmates or offenders who have committed this crime more than once. DOC only has three people on community supervision who have ever been convicted for "patronizing a prostitute" under Wis. Stat. 944.31.
