Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill specifies that neither the Department nor a county can prohibit the operation of an event facility and lodging establishment in buildings that existed prior to the effective date of this proposal and that are on property wholly or partially within the Lower St. Croix Riverway that was historically used as a recreational campground. In addition, the bill eliminates the requirement for written Department consent for amendments/modifications to Lower St. Croix Riverway ordinances and for a variance granted by the regulating municipality.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the Department of Natural Resources.

Local units of government would incur indeterminate costs to update zoning ordinances in accordance with the provisions of the bill.
