Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill prohibits a person from selling or transferring any firearm unless the sale or transfer occurs through a federally-licensed firearms dealer and involves a background check of the prospective transferee.

Since the Department does not administer regulatory programs associated with the purchase or transfer of firearms, and conservation wardens do not have statutory authority to investigate unlawful firearm transfers (as described in this bill), the Department does not anticipate any fiscal effect from this proposal.
