Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates the Badger Health Benefit Authority. The Authority is defined as a "state agency" in determining eligibility for participation in the Wisconsin Retirement System.

The bill also requires the Secretary of the Department of Employee Trust Funds to serve on the board.
