Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill increases the Elections Commission staffing level from 25.75 to 31.75 FTE. Currently, 16.0 FTE positions are federally funded pursuant to the Help America Vote Act of 2002 (HAVA). The agency anticipates that the remaining federal HAVA funds will be expended during FY 19. The agency has adequate federal funds to support the additional 5.0 FTE positions through FY 18 and a portion of FY 19. The bill authorizes the use of available federal funds to support the positions in FY 18 and the use of GPR funds to support the additional positions in FY 19 after the HAVA funds are exhausted.

If the bill is enacted, the agency anticipates restoring staff positions eliminated during the 2017 - 2019 budget process. Those positions include three Elections Specialists focused on tasks related to election administration, the statewide voter registration system, voter outreach, voting equipment certification and audits, and the security of election systems, as well as one administrative support position and one legal assistant position.
