Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Local Fiscal Effect: Under current law the municipality or county that petitions WisDOT to condemn the sign instead of realigning the sign, must pay WisDOT for certain costs of condemnation if the sign is condemned. There is no reasonable way to determine the totality of the cost increase to local units of government on an annual basis because the number of local conflicts with future sign placement is unknown.
