Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, the Department awards \$250,000 GPR biennially in grants to provide crisis intervention and training programs to law enforcement agencies and correctional officers. This bill would increase the crisis intervention team training grants to \$1,000,000 GPR per biennium. The bill also allows the grant funding to be used to cover overtime costs.

This bill would increase state expenses in the biennial appropriation 20.435 (5) (cd) by \$750,000 GPR, with \$375,000 GPR available in FY 18 and an additional \$375,000 GPR available in FY 19. The bill does not provide any funding for the implementation of the bill, but the Department would be able to absorb the increased workload with its current resources.
