## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill requires that a correctional officer be present during each interaction between a prisoner who is in segregated status and any staff member who is not a correctional officer. Since this bill does not define "correctional officer," the Department of Corrections (DOC) is assuming that "correctional officer" is meant in the broadest sense and includes correctional sergeants.

The DOC does not anticipate that there is a state fiscal impact to this bill. It is current DOC policy that correctional officers or sergeants place restricted status inmates in physical restraints and escort them any time they are out of their cell. Furthermore, when inmates in restricted status meet with medical or treatment staff outside of their cell, they are placed in physical restraints and the interaction is monitored by a correctional officer or sergeant.
