Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill would require the department to promulgate rules establishing uniform procedures for a municipality to administer the commercial building code. The bill would require additional rule making related to standards for carbon monoxide detectors and examination requirements for licensure by the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board. The department estimates that it would require 174 hours of staff time to complete the rule making, at a cost of approximately \$6,700.
