Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires the UW System Board of Regents to maintain a nanotechnology information hub, for at least five years, to promote the development of nanotechnology businesses in this state, and gather and disseminate information about environmental health and workplace safety related to nanotechnology.

The bill creates a nanotechnology council. The members include the secretary of workforce development or the secretary's designee. The council meets at least twice each year and must develop and implement plans for the nanotechnology information hub to sustain its own funding.

If the bill is enacted, the Department of Workforce Development estimates the costs related to the participation of the secretary or designee on the council would be indeterminate but likely absorbable within DWD's existing budget.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
