Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill increases the tipped employee minimum wage from \$2.33 to \$3.28 six months after enactment. The bill then raises this wage to \$7.08 per hour through a series of annual increases of \$.95. Once this wage rate is reached, the bill eliminates the separate tipped minimum wage altogether, subjecting these employees to the general minimum wage (currently \$7.25 per hour or \$5.90 an hour for opportunity employees).

The Department of Workforce Development estimates that this legislation would create 300 additional wage complaints annually that cannot be fielded, investigated, or resolved at current staffing levels within the Department's Division of the Equal Rights. To meet this increased workload, 2.0 FTE Equal Rights Officers would need to be hired at an added annual cost of \$137,000 GPR. There would be a one-time GPR start-up cost of \$7,000 to staff the two positions. Finally, additional one-time GPR costs of \$5000 are needed to update and reprint existing documentation relating to minimum wage laws.
