Pursuant to Senate Rule 46 (2)(c), I am writing to inform you that I have directed the following proposals to be withdrawn from committee and rereferred. I have obtained the consent of the appropriate standing committee chairperson and the chairperson of the committee on **Senate Organization**.

Assembly Bill 691, relating to: eligible bidders at foreclosure sales, eligible purchasers of foreclosed property, and providing a penalty., withdrawn from the committee on **Insurance, Financial Services, Constitution and Federalism** and rereferred to the committee on **Senate Organization**.

Assembly Bill 690, relating to: authorizing counties to conduct foreclosure sales using an Internet-based auction., withdrawn from the committee on **Insurance, Financial Services, Constitution and Federalism** and rereferred to the committee on **Senate Organization**.

Assembly Bill 771, relating to: the authority of political subdivisions to regulate rental properties and historic properties and of municipalities to inspect dwellings, public utility service to rental dwelling units, landlord and tenant regulations, fees imposed by a political subdivision, certain levy limit reductions, certain procedural changes in eviction actions, information available on the consolidated court automated Internet site, discrimination in housing against individuals who keep certain animals, falsely claiming an animal to be a service animal, municipal administrative procedure, enforcement of the rental unit energy efficiency program, and providing penalties., withdrawn from the committee on **Insurance, Financial Services, Constitution and Federalism** and rereferred to the committee on **Senate Organization**.
