2017 Wisconsin Act 55
[2017 Senate Bill 90]

**Removal and Replacement of a
Vehicle or a Vehicle Part
Identification Number**

Wisconsin law generally prohibits a person from removing, altering, obliterating, or intentionally making it impossible to read a vehicle identification number. 2017 Wisconsin Act 55 adds an exception to this prohibition for a person who repairs a vehicle or vehicle part to remove and replace a decal that contains a vehicle identification number if the removal and replacement is reasonably necessary for the repair.
