2017 Wisconsin Act 84
[2017 Senate Bill 99]

**Designating and Marking the
Richard A. Grobschmidt
Memorial Bridge**

2017 Wisconsin Act 84 directs the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to designate the bridge on the Hank Aaron State Trail across the Lakeshore Park Inlet at the north end of Lakeshore State Park in the City of Milwaukee as the “Richard A. Grobschmidt Memorial Bridge.” The Act also requires DNR, upon receiving sufficient contributions from interested parties, including any county, city, village, or town, to erect markers designating this trail. No state funds may be expended for the erection or maintenance of these markers, except for contributions DNR has received from interested parties for these purposes.

Effective date: 2017 Act 84 takes effect on November 30, 2017.
