



WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2017 Wisconsin Act 207
[2017 Assembly Bill 836]

Populous Counties

Under prior law, the statutes contained certain standards that applied only to counties with a population of 500,000 or more (often referred to as “populous counties”). 2017 Wisconsin Act 207 raises the population threshold for populous counties so that those provisions apply instead to counties with a population of 750,000 or more.
