2017 Wisconsin Act 210
[2017 Senate Bill 667]

Livestock Premises Registration

Wisconsin's livestock premises registration law generally requires a person to register the location where he or she keeps certain types of livestock with the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP).

2017 Wisconsin Act 210 provides DATCP additional funding to administer the livestock premises registration program. Prior to the Act, the Legislature appropriated \$250,000 annually for fiscal years 2017-18 and 2018-19. The Act increases these appropriations by \$100,000 for both fiscal years.
