2017 Wisconsin Act 288
[2017 Assembly Bill 834]

Chiropractic Exams

2017 Wisconsin Act 288 reduces the required score on Parts III and IV of the chiropractic licensure exam administered by the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners to 375, and specifies that a score of 375 is sufficient regardless of when the person took the exam. The Act first applies to an application for a license to practice as a chiropractor that is received by the Department of Safety and Professional Services on April 18, 2018.
