2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 314

2017 Assembly Bill 314 allows a person to possess and hunt with a loaded firearm, crossbow, or a bow from a vehicle if the person is legally hunting from a platform elevated by a mechanized lift attached to a motor vehicle equipped with stabilizers, if the lift, platform, and stabilizers are all commercially manufactured in compliance with applicable standards of the American National Standards Institute, the vehicle is parked and the motor used to drive the vehicle is not in operation, the stabilizers are deployed and in full contact with the ground, and the lift is in a raised position and the platform is stationary.

ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 allows a person to possess and hunt with a loaded firearm, crossbow, or a bow from a stationary vehicle if the person is legally hunting from a part of the vehicle or a piece of equipment attached to the vehicle that is raised by mechanical means not fewer than five feet above the ground or above the lowered resting position of the part or piece of equipment, whichever is higher.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Spiros on June 12, 2017. On June 13, 2017, the Assembly Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage recommended adoption of the substitute amendment and passage of the bill, as amended, by unanimous votes.
