2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 402

Assembly Bill 402 creates a sales and use tax exemption for tangible personal property and taxable services sold to a state veterans organization, as well as a sales and use tax exemption for building materials purchased by a contractor and transferred to a state veterans organization.

ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 revises the proposed sales and use tax exemption to retain the taxability of the sale to a veterans organization of products used primarily in preparing, storing, serving, selling, or delivering food and beverages sold by the organization.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Jacque introduced Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 on February 13, 2018. On February 14, 2018, the Assembly Committee on Ways and Means recommended adoption of Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 10; Noes 5, and recommended passage of Assembly Bill 402, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 11; Noes, 4.
