2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 732

2017 Assembly Bill 732 requires the Department of Veterans Affairs to administer a pilot program to provide outreach, mental health services, and support to certain individuals who are serving or who have served in the armed forces and who have a mental health condition or substance abuse disorder. The bill appropriates \$538,521 for fiscal year 2017-18 and \$719,779 for fiscal year 2018-19 to fund the pilot program.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 decreases the appropriation for fiscal year 2017-18, provided in the bill, by \$358,541, and increases the appropriation for fiscal year 2018-19, provided in the bill, by \$21.

BILL HISTORY

The Joint Committee on Finance offered Assembly Amendment 1 on February 7, 2018. Also on February 7, 2018, the Joint Committee on Finance voted unanimously to recommend adoption of the amendment and passage of Assembly Bill 732, as amended.
