## 2017 SENATE BILL 435

2017 Senate Bill 435 allows an emergency medical technician or a first responder to render first aid services to a sick or injured domestic animal, in certain cases.

## SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 harmonizes the terminology used in the bill with that in 2017 Wisconsin Act 12, including the terms "emergency medical responder," "emergency medical technician," "emergency medical technician – intermediate," "advanced emergency medical technician," and "paramedic" to refer to individual provider levels, and the umbrella term "emergency medical services practitioners" to refer to various emergency service providers.

## **BILL HISTORY**

Senator Cowles offered Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to 2017 Senate Bill 435 on January 19, 2018. On January 23, 2018, the Senate voted to adopt Substitute Amendment 1 and pass Senate Bill 435, as amended.
